WARD NEWS FOR JUNE 2010

One third of recorded crime involves criminal damage

48 crimes were recorded across the ward in June (May 36). As last month, at least a third of these involved criminal damage to property. 11 cases of assault included one on a police constable and one case of malicious wounding. Four burglaries were recorded (all in Brigg) and 15 cases of theft.

Other concerns addressed by the Brigg and Wolds Neighbourhood Police Team during June 2010

The greater proportion of the work of Neighbourhood Police Teams relates to public and individual needs and concerns that are not directly crime-related.

In June 2010, 227 concerns were responded to by the Brigg and Wolds team (compared with 183 in May) as follows:

Concerns about property	33
Concerns about individuals and safety	25
Concerns about behaviour	102
Concerns about traffic	67

Individual incidents vary enormously in the amount of police time required to deal with them.

REPORTS FOR JUNE 2010 FROM YOUR LOCAL AREA

Brigg

Recorded crimes:

32 crimes were recorded in Brigg during the month including:

- 1 x Malicious wounding
- 3 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 3 x Common assault
- 1 x Assault on a constable
- 4 x Burglary (one in a dwelling)
- 7 x Criminal damage to property

- 1 x Fraud
- 8 x Theft
- 1 x Possessing a controlled drug

130 other incidents and matters of individual or community concern have been reported in June, including:

- 9 reports of missing persons
- 7 reports of suspicious behaviour
- 6 concerns for the safety of individuals
- 4 domestic incidents
- 15 reports of rowdy or inconsiderate behaviour
- 16 reports of violence/assault or harassment
- 25 traffic related matters

Wrawby

Recorded crimes:

- 1 x Theft

8 other matters included two domestic/neighbour disputes, two traffic related concerns, two reports of suspicious activity and a faulty burglar alarm.

Elsham

Recorded crimes:

- 1 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 1 x Criminal damage to property
- 2 x theft (one of a motor vehicle)

19 other matters were addressed, ten of which were traffic-related. The remainder related to individual needs and problems and raise no issues of wider public concern.

Barnetby

Recorded crimes:

- 1 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 2 x Criminal damage to property
- 4 x Theft (two from a motor vehicle)
- 1 x Interference with a motor vehicle

No less than 57 other concerns were addressed (more than twice the number logged in May). These included.

- 25 Traffic related concerns
- 10 Property relation concerns (suspected theft, fraud, abandoned vehicles etc – in all cases there is insufficient evidence to suggest that crime has been committed)
- 4 concerns for the safety of individuals
- 6 cases of disputes within the home or between neighbours

5 reports of rowdy or inconsiderate behaviour
6 reports of suspicious activity

Bonby

Recorded crimes:

1 x Assault causing actual bodily harm

7 other matters have been addressed, including three reports of rowdy behaviour.

Worlaby

Recorded crimes:

1 x Criminal damage to property

7 other matters have been dealt with, including 3 involving rowdy, suspicious or inconsiderate behaviour and 3 involving domestic disputes.

Saxby All Saints

No recorded crimes:

A report was received from an individual who had found a £5 note.

Horkstow

No recorded crimes:

Concerns have been reported re inconsiderate driving and parking as well as a suspicious vehicle on private land.

South Ferriby

Recorded crimes:

1 x Criminal damage to a property

26 other matters have been dealt with (twice as many as in May), mostly not property related. 8 related to disputes between neighbours or within the home, 5 involved inconsiderate or suspicious behaviour, and 3 were traffic related.

Melton Ross

No recorded crimes:

One case of highway disruption was reported.

New Barnetby

No recorded crimes:

No other matters of concern have been reported.
