Apologies

Declaration of Interests

Flooding Presentation

A presentation was made by Geoff Popple's Team from North Lincolnshire Council (attached – Appendix A) on flooding and potential future flooding in our area. The Parish Council were advised that problem areas have been identified and work on these is ongoing. A NL Flood Forum has been formed and has now met three times. The importance of Councils, outside Agencies and the general public working together was stressed as was the power of local knowledge supplied by individuals and Parish Councils.

Any Questions / Discussion

a. Flooding in Andrew's Road was raised and **it was resolved** for Cllr Mouncey to meet with Wayne Hill to discuss this further as well as the clearing of the two dykes on the Humber Bank. **ACTION: DM / WH**

b. Following discussion it was agreed by all parties that surface water flooding and the proximity of the village to the Humber need looking at together.

c. NLC agreed to look at the gully system on Low Street. **ACTION: NLC**

d. NLC agreed to look at the dykes on the boundary of the Churchyard on Parson's Hill. **ACTION: NLC**

e. It was confirmed that funding for the re-surfacing of the A1077 has been received and that work is likely to commence in Autumn 2008.

f. Discussion took place regarding the road outside South Ferriby School and it was suggested that work to this could possibly take place later this year though this is by no means certain.

g. A Household Emergency Plan and Community Emergency Plan have been prepared by NLC and these will be forwarded to the Clerk. **ACTION: NLC**

A Member of the public raised the subject of provision for vulnerable / elderly people in the village in the case of an emergency and the Parish Council explained that a Floodplan is nearing completion with emphasis on dealing with the above groups.
