WARD NEWS FOR MARCH 2014

March crime total below average

26 crimes were recorded from all the villages and areas covered by the Brigg and Wolds Ward in March 2014, of which 17 were in the Brigg town area, including the M180. The average monthly total is around 43.

Other concerns addressed by the Brigg and Wolds Neighbourhood Police Team during March 2014

The greater proportion of the work of Neighbourhood Police Teams relates to public and individual needs and concerns that are not directly crime-related.

In March 2014, 163 concerns were responded to by the Brigg and Wolds team as follows –

Concerns about property	15
Concerns about individuals and safety	20
Concerns about behaviour	74
Concerns about traffic	54

Individual incidents vary enormously in the amount of police time required to deal with them. In a good proportion of cases people's legitimate suspicions and concerns prove to be unfounded.

REPORTS FOR MARCH 2014 FROM YOUR LOCAL AREA

Brigg

Recorded crimes in March 2014

17 crimes were recorded in Brigg during the month of march – I have included a bit more info' as some are recorded by full definition and some times ambiguous.....

- 1 x ABH (assault)
- 1 x Burglary in a dwelling
- 2 x Burglary not in dwelling
- 1 x Theft by an employee
- 1 x Theft of a pedal cycle
- 1 x Theft from a motor vehicle
- 3 x Theft from a shop
- 1 x Theft (cable)
- 1 x Possessing cannabis

- 1 x Common Assault
- 1 x Theft (from outside a business)
- 2 x Damage to property
- 1 x Damage caused to vehicle on M180

A total of 94 other incidents and matters of individual or community concern have been reported in March, including:

- 21 civil or domestic or inter-personal incidents
- 11 incidents where there was concern for the safety of individuals
- 3 sudden death
- 2 reports of rowdy or nuisance behaviour
- 25 traffic related matters
- 15 other reports of suspicious activity

Wrawby

No recorded crimes in March 2014

A vehicle in a field suspected of being linked to poachers proved to belong to the farmer. An individual reported being bitten by a dog.

Elsham

Recorded crimes in March 2014

- 2 x Theft from a motor vehicle (Fuel theft from Industrial Estate business)

Police were called to a sudden death in the village. Elsewhere there were five traffic related incidents, including when the driver of a lorry became unwell. A suspicious individual was reported near the level crossing.

Barnetby

Recorded crimes in March 2014

- 1 x Fraud (Dealt with by Action Fraud)
- 1 x Robbery (Barnetby Top Business)
- 2 x Making off without paying (Barnetby Top Business)

Police were called on 41 other occasions, 23 of which involved highway disruption or alleged traffic offences. Police were called to four incidents where there was tension between individuals. There were three reports of rowdy behaviour and six other suspicious incidents.

Bonby

No recorded crimes in March 2014

Three calls related to concerns for individuals. A dog was reported lost, and in a separate incident later in the month a vehicle was in collision with a dog.

Worlaby

No recorded crimes in March 2014

A silver Land Rover was reported lamping. A similar vehicle was also reported in the Barnetby area.

Saxby All Saints

No recorded crimes in March 2014

Sheep were reported on the road. A caller reported concern after an incident on Facebook. Police were also called to a domestic dispute.

Horkstow

No recorded crimes in March 2014

No other matters required police attention.

South Ferriby

Recorded crimes in March 2014

- 1 x Theft (from outside a property)
- 1 x Theft of a pedal cycle
- 1 x Fraud (again, dealt with by Action Fraud)

Police were called on seven occasions with a variety of suspicions and concerns – including two incidents involving vehicles loaded with scrap.

Melton Ross and New Barnetby

No recorded crimes in March 2014

A report was received of fly-tipping in Middlegate Lane.
