Other concerns addressed by the Brigg and Wolds Neighbourhood Police Team during July 2015

The greater proportion of the work of Neighbourhood Police Teams relates to public and individual needs and concerns that are not directly crime-related.

In July 2015, 149 concerns were responded to by the Brigg and Wolds team as follows –

Concerns about property	7
Concerns about individuals and safety	30
Concerns about behaviour	52
Concerns about traffic	60

Individual incidents vary enormously in the amount of police time required to deal with them. In a good proportion of cases people's legitimate suspicions and concerns prove to be unfounded.

Recorded crimes in July 2015

44 crimes were recorded in Brigg during the month – made up of:

A total of 86 other incidents and matters of individual or community concern have been reported in July, including:

- 22 civil or domestic or inter-personal incidents
- 11 incidents where there was concern for the safety of individuals
 - 1 sudden death
 - 5 reports of rowdy or nuisance behaviour
- 27 traffic related matters
 - 2 other reports of suspicious activity

Wrawby

Recorded crimes in July 2015

Other Criminal Damage less than £5000	1
Common assault and battery	1

Police were called on three occasions when callers expressed concern for the safety of individuals. Police were also called in after part of Vicarage Road collapsed into a hole.

Elsham

Recorded crimes in July 2015

Police were called over a lost bag. Three road traffic incidents were reported.

Barnetby

Police were called on 28 other occasions, of which 20 involved traffic related incidents – all but three on the motorway or A180. Police were called on six occasions over concerns for the safety of individuals. They were also called to a sudden death and to a domestic dispute.

Bonby

No recorded crimes in July 2015

Police were called after fly tipping was seen in Middlegate Lane, and when an individual was seen acting suspiciously. A caller also reported mud on the road.

Worlaby

Police were called after two young people went missing.

Saxby All Saints

Recorded crimes in July 2015

Police were called to a domestic incident (no offences).

Police were called when youths in cars were at Horkstow Bridge.

Police were called on six occasions with concerns for the safety of individuals – five relating to the same person. Police were also called in when breeze blocks at the road side caused obstruction, and after a road traffic collision.
