WARD NEWS FOR OCTOBER 2015

Crime total in October lower than this year's average

35 crimes were recorded in the Brigg and Wolds Ward in October 2015, of which 21 were in Brigg town.

Other concerns addressed by the Brigg and Wolds Neighbourhood Police Team during October 2015

The greater proportion of the work of Neighbourhood Police Teams relates to public and individual needs and concerns that are not directly crime-related.

In October 2015, 112 concerns were responded to by the Brigg and Wolds team as follows –

Concerns about property	11
Concerns about individuals and safety	13
Concerns about behaviour	35
Concerns about traffic	53

Individual incidents vary enormously in the amount of police time required to deal with them. In a good proportion of cases people's legitimate suspicions and concerns prove to be unfounded.

Recorded crimes in October 2015

Police were called three times to an underage party where youths were attempting to gate-crash. A caller reported finding diesel, possibly stolen. Four road related offences were reported. On two occasions individuals taking photographs aroused concern and suspicion.
