WARD NEWS FOR APRIL 2013

Low levels of crime in April

30 crimes were recorded in the Brigg and Wolds Ward in April 2013 (45 were recorded in March). 18 of these crimes were in Brigg town. Across the ward 20 incidents involved theft (including three motor vehicles), and seven involved assault. There were no domestic burglaries this month.

Other concerns addressed by the Brigg and Wolds Neighbourhood Police Team during April 2013

The greater proportion of the work of Neighbourhood Police Teams relates to public and individual needs and concerns that are not directly crime-related.

In April 2013, 176 concerns were responded to by the Brigg and Wolds team (considerably more than usual) as follows –

Concerns about property

Concerns about individuals and safety

Concerns about behaviour

Concerns about traffic

Individual incidents vary enormously in the amount of police time required to deal with them. In a good proportion of cases people's legitimate suspicions and concerns prove to be unfounded.

REPORTS FOR APRIL 2013 FROM YOUR LOCAL AREA

Brigg

Recorded crimes in April 2013

18 crimes were recorded in Brigg during the month made up of:

- 3 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 3 x Common assault & Battery
- 2 x Burglary not in dwelling
- 1 x Criminal damage (to property)

- 1 x Fraud by false representation
- 1 x Theft of a motor vehicle
- 1 x Theft from a (motor) vehicle
- 3 x Theft from a shop
- 2 x Theft in a dwelling
- 1 x Theft (other)

A total of 97 other incidents and matters of individual or community concern have been reported in April, including:

- 11 civil or domestic or inter-personal incidents
- 19 incidents where there was concern for the safety of individuals, including missing persons
- 12 reports of rowdy or nuisance behaviour
- 18 traffic related matters
- 20 other reports of suspicious activity

Wrawby

No recorded crimes in April 2013

13 other calls were received, including reports of a lost ring, four traffic related incidents (including a man falling off his cycle), and a report of youths causing annoyance in the churchyard. Four calls involved an elderly couple where there was concern for their safety.

Elsham

Recorded crimes in April 2013

1 x Theft in a shop (at Barnetby Top services) 1 x Theft of a vehicle (at Elsham Garage Services)

2 x Theft (other) (at Elsham Garage Services and on the industrial estate)

From the village a report was received of possible drug misuse. Three traffic-related incidents were also dealt with. Elsewhere seven other incidents were all on the A15 or M180, including a stray dog and an individual thumbing a lift on the motorway.

Barnetby

Recorded crimes in April 2013

1 x Burglary not in a dwelling

37 other concerns have required police attention. 18 of these were traffic-related. Other calls included eight incidents where there was concern for the safety of individuals, and various individuals and vehicles that have aroused callers' suspicions.

Bonby

No recorded crimes in April 2013

Four other calls involved concern for the safety of the same individual. A complaint was received about a neighbour's bonfire; a caller also reported that her ex-partner was in the house.

Worlaby

Recorded crimes in April 2013

1 x Burglary not in a dwelling

1 x Theft (other)

(Both on local farms)

Six other calls involved youths throwing fireworks and banging on doors, a missing person returning safe and well, a report of fly tipping, and a dispute about a neighbour's dog.

Saxby All Saints

Recorded crimes in April 2013

1 x Burglary not in a dwelling

(on a local farm)

Concern was reported about the safety of an individual with dementia.

Horkstow

No recorded crimes in April 2013

A caller reported people who were fishing illegally. A similar report came from South Ferriby.

South Ferriby

Recorded crimes in April 2013

- 1 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 1 x Harassment
- 1 x Theft of a motor vehicle

Illegal fishing was reported (cf Horkstow); an individual was reported missing; nuisance motorcycles were again reported in the guarry; and an assault was alleged.

Melton Ross and New Barnetby

Recorded crimes in April 2013
