WARD NEWS FOR JUNE 2013

Lower level of crime in June

32 crimes were recorded in the Brigg and Wolds Ward in June 2013 (42 were recorded in May). 22 of these crimes were in Brigg town. Across the ward 8 incidents involved criminal damage, 10 involved theft and six involved assault. As last month there was just one case of domestic burglary – in Brigg.

Other concerns addressed by the Brigg and Wolds Neighbourhood Police Team during June 2013

The greater proportion of the work of Neighbourhood Police Teams relates to public and individual needs and concerns that are not directly crime-related.

In June 2013, 168 concerns were responded to by the Brigg and Wolds team as follows -

Concerns about property

Concerns about individuals and safety

Concerns about behaviour

Concerns about traffic

Individual incidents vary enormously in the amount of police time required to deal with them. In a good proportion of cases people's legitimate suspicions and concerns prove to be unfounded.



REPORTS FOR JUNE 2013 FROM YOUR LOCAL AREA

Brigg

Recorded crimes in June 2013

22 crimes were recorded in Brigg during the month made up of:

- 1 x Malicious wounding
- 2 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 1 x Common assault & Battery
- 1 x Inter-personal offence
- 3 x Burglary not in dwelling
- 1 x Burglary in a dwelling
- 3 x Criminal damage (to property)
- 2 x Theft of a pedal cycle
- 3 x Theft from a shop
- 1 x Theft from the person
- 3 x Theft (other)
- 1 x Breach of non-molestation order

A total of 112 other incidents and matters of individual or community concern have been reported in June, including:

26 civil or domestic or inter-personal incidents

12 incidents where there was concern for the safety of individuals, including missing persons and one report of a sudden death

5 reports of rowdy or nuisance behaviour

30 traffic related matters

15 other reports of suspicious activity

Wrawby

No recorded crimes in June 2013

A vehicle was reported tailgating an ambulance at high speed on the motorway. A wheel from a vehicle involved in a traffic collision on Melton Road was found in a garden. A caller reported being harassed by nuisance phone calls, and police were called with concerns for the safety of a lady who had collapsed.

Elsham

Recorded crimes in June 2013

1 x Criminal damage

(to farm gates on Elsham Wold)

A sudden death was reported in Elsham village. Four traffic incidents were reported from the motorway and the A15. On Elsham Wolds, a business reported a hoax phone call, and another company reported a suspicious vehicle on site.

Barnetby

Recorded crimes in June 2013

- 1 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 3 x Criminal damage (to property)
- 1 x Theft from a (motor) vehicle
- 1 x Theft (other)

33 other concerns have required police attention. 13 of these were traffic-related. Other calls included six concerns for the safety of individuals, a sudden death, seven civil or domestic incidents, and a suspected fraud.

Bonby

Recorded crimes in June 2013

1 x Inter-personal offence

No other matters have required police attention.

Worlaby

No recorded crimes in June 2013

Police were regarding a suspected fraud, a pedal cycle that had been found, a noisy party and possible hare-coursers. There were also two calls reporting concern for the safety of individuals.

Saxby All Saints

Recorded crimes in June 2013

1 x Theft (other)

No other matters have required police attention.

Horkstow

No recorded crimes in June 2013

Police were called to people using scrambler bikes on the side of the River Ancholme and camping under Horkstow Bridge.

South Ferriby
