WARD NEWS FOR SEPTEMBER 2014

Crime total in September remains well below average

29 crimes were recorded in the Brigg and Wolds Ward in September 2014 (same total as in August), of which 22 were in Brigg town. The average monthly total is around 43. There were 13 incidences of theft and one of 'making off without paying' from a petrol station. There were 3 burglaries (two in dwellings, both in Brigg), 4 offences involving criminal damage (3 in Brigg) and 7 incidents where there was assault or harassment – one of these being associated with race hatred. A charge has also been recorded of misconduct in public office.

Other concerns addressed by the Brigg and Wolds Neighbourhood Police Team during September 2014

The greater proportion of the work of Neighbourhood Police Teams relates to public and individual needs and concerns that are not directly crime-related.

In September 2014, 167 concerns were responded to by the Brigg and Wolds team as follows –

Concerns about property	24
Concerns about individuals and safety	33
Concerns about behaviour	63
Concerns about traffic	47

Individual incidents vary enormously in the amount of police time required to deal with them. In a good proportion of cases people's legitimate suspicions and concerns prove to be unfounded.

REPORTS FOR SEPTEMBER 2014 FROM YOUR LOCAL AREA

Brigg

Recorded crimes in September 2014

22 crimes were recorded in Brigg during the month – made up of:

- 1 x Threats to kill
- 3 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 2 x Burglary in a dwelling
- 1 x Burglary not in dwelling
- 1 x Theft in a dwelling
- 3 x Theft of a pedal cycle
- 1 x Theft from a (motor) vehicle
- 4 x Theft from shops and stalls
- 1 x Theft (other)
- 1 x Misconduct in public office
- 3 x Criminal damage (to property)
- 1 x Race

A total of 84 other incidents and matters of individual or community concern have been reported in September, including:

- 18 civil or domestic or inter-personal incidents
- 20 incidents where there was concern for the safety of individuals
- 0 sudden death
- 2 reports of rowdy or nuisance behaviour
- 16 traffic related matters
- 12 other reports of suspicious activity

Wrawby

Recorded crimes in September 2014

- 1 x Assault causing actual bodily harm

Police were called to two incidents of highway disruption on the motorway and when a quilt had apparently been dumped on the verge of the A18. A caller also reported hitting a gas pipe whilst gardening.

Elsham

Recorded crimes in September 2014

- 1 x Making off without paying
- 1 x Common assault and battery
- 1 x Theft (other)

(None of the above occurred in Elsham Village)

Police were called with two reports of possible poachers, about 3 cases of suspected fraud (two on the industrial estate), and about two possible cases of assault. No crimes were recorded. Eight traffic incidents were attended, all but one outside the village.

Barnetby

Recorded crimes in September 2014

- 1 x Criminal damage
- 1 x Theft (other)

Police were called on 35 other occasions, 16 of which involved traffic collisions, highway disruption or alleged traffic offences. Police were called on six occasions to domestic disputes or where there was tension between individuals. Five callers reported concern for other people's safety.

Bonby

No recorded crimes in September 2014

Police were called with two reports of possible poaching. They were also called to a domestic dispute. Three callers were concerned about the safety of individuals.

Worlaby

Recorded crimes in September 2014

- 1 x Theft in a dwelling

Police were called to deal with seven traffic related matters. Two incidents of possible drug misuse were reported, as well as an alleged assault and three other matters that aroused suspicion.

Saxby All Saints

No recorded crimes in September 2014

Police were called when suspicious individuals appeared in the caller's driveway.

Horkstow

No recorded crimes in September 2014

Police were called after a caller found a dead badger in suspicious circumstances.

South Ferriby

No recorded crimes in September 2014

Police were also called after a vehicle collided with a deer. Police also attended after a domestic dispute.

Melton Ross and New Barnetby

No recorded crimes in September 2014

Police were called to four traffic related incidents.
