WARD NEWS FOR MARCH 2015

Crime total in March marginally above average

46 crimes were recorded in the Brigg and Wolds Ward in March 2015, of which 30 were in Brigg town. The average monthly total is around 43. Across the Ward, there were 24 incidences of theft (including two of making off without paying), and 5 of burglary (one in a dwelling). There were 6 incidents of assault, 10 involving criminal damage and one offence of growing a cannabis plant.

Other concerns addressed by the Brigg and Wolds Neighbourhood Police Team during March 2015

The greater proportion of the work of Neighbourhood Police Teams relates to public and individual needs and concerns that are not directly crime-related.

In March 2015, 136 concerns were responded to by the Brigg and Wolds team as follows -

Individual incidents vary enormously in the amount of police time required to deal with them. In a good proportion of cases people's legitimate suspicions and concerns prove to be unfounded.



REPORTS FOR MARCH 2015 FROM YOUR LOCAL AREA

Brigg

Recorded crimes in March 2015

30 crimes were recorded in Brigg during the month – made up of:

- 3 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 2 x Inter-personal offence
- 1 x Other burglary in a dwelling
- 3 x Other burglary in a building other than a dwelling
- 2 x Theft in a dwelling
- 1 x Theft from a motor vehicle
- 5 x Theft from shops and stalls
- 6 x Theft (other)
- 1 x Production of a cannabis plant
- 1 x Common assault and battery
- 1 x Interference with a vehicle
- 4 x Criminal damage

A total of 68 other incidents and matters of individual or community concern have been reported in March, including:

- 16 civil or domestic or inter-personal incidents
- 13 incidents where there was concern for the safety of individuals
- 1 sudden death
- 1 reports of rowdy or nuisance behaviour
- 13 traffic related matters
- 17 other reports of suspicious activity

Wrawby

Recorded crimes in March 2015

- 1 x Aggravated vehicle taking
- 1 x Theft from a motor vehicle
- 1 x Criminal damage (to property)

Police were called by people concerned for the safety of two individuals, one who was taking photos of trains, and the other on a motorway bridge. A caller reported a suspicious white van, and police gave advice on a case of alleged harassment.

Elsham



Recorded crimes in March 2015

1 x Theft from a vehicle (on the Industrial Estate)
1 x Making off without paying
1 x Criminal damage (at Barnetby Top Services)
(at Barnetby Top Services)

In the village Police were called to three road traffic incidents and to a case of alleged harassment. Elsewhere suspected poachers were reported and Police dealt with six other road traffic incidents (on the motorway or A15).

Barnetby

Recorded crimes in March 2015

- 1 x Theft from a motor vehicle
- 1 x Criminal damage

Police were called on 43 other occasions, no less than 32 of which involved traffic collisions, highway disruption or alleged traffic offences — all but three on the motorway or A180. Eight of the remaining calls involved civil or domestic tensions or disputes. A caller also reported a neighbour's vehicle unattended with the doors open — all proved to be in order.

Bonby

Recorded crimes in March 2015

1x Criminal damage

Police were called on two occasions, one being as domestic issue, the other a dispute between neighbours.

Worlaby

Recorded crimes in March 2015

1 x Theft from a motor vehicle

A caller reported seeing an individual thought to be wanted by Police.

Saxby All Saints

Recorded crimes in March 2015

1 x Theft from a motor vehicle

Police were also called to a sudden death.

Horkstow

No recorded crimes in March 2015

No other matters required police attention.

South Ferriby

Recorded crimes in March 2015

- 1 x Making off without paying
- 1 x Criminal damage

Police were also called to a dispute over a parcel, to an alleged domestic assault, and on three occasions that aroused suspicions. Vehicles were also reported driving at speed round the village.

Melton Ross and New Barnetby

Recorded crimes in March 2015

- 1 x Other burglary in a building other than a dwelling at the quarry
- 1 x Theft from vehicle other than a motor vehicle at the quarry
- 1 x Theft (other)

A fault with temporary traffic lights was reported on the A180.
