WARD NEWS FOR SEPTEMBER 2015

Crime total in September much lower than recent months

31 crimes were recorded in the Brigg and Wolds Ward in September 2015, of which 25 were in Brigg town.

Other concerns addressed by the Brigg and Wolds Neighbourhood Police Team during September 2015

The greater proportion of the work of Neighbourhood Police Teams relates to public and individual needs and concerns that are not directly crime-related.

In September 2015, 132 concerns were responded to by the Brigg and Wolds team as follows –

Concerns about property	15
Concerns about individuals and safety	8
Concerns about behaviour	61
Concerns about traffic	10

Individual incidents vary enormously in the amount of police time required to deal with them. In a good proportion of cases people's legitimate suspicions and concerns prove to be unfounded.

Brigg

Recorded crimes in September 2015

25 crimes were recorded in Brigg during the month – made up of:

Theft if not classified elsewhere	6
Theft from a motor vehicle	3
Assault occasioning actual bodily harm	3
Racially or religiously aggravated intentional harassment, alarm or distress.	1
Burglary in a building other than a dwelling	3
Action Fraud	2

A total of 72 other incidents and matters of individual or community concern have been reported in September, including:

- 14 civil or domestic or inter-personal incidents
- 4 incidents where there was concern for the safety of individuals
- 0 sudden death
- 7 reports of rowdy or nuisance behaviour
- 18 traffic related matters
- 5 other reports of suspicious activity

Wrawby

No recorded crimes in September 2015

Police were called when a youth aroused suspicion by looking in the windows of parked cars. A road traffic incident was also reported – no injuries.

Elsham

Recorded crimes in September 2015

Theft from a motor vehicle	(Barnetby Top)	1

From the village, police received two traffic related calls. 25 further traffic related incidents requiring police attention were reported around Barnetby Top.

Traffic incidents on the motorway and the A15/ A180 intersection are now listed under Elsham (Barnetby Top). Police were called from the village on eight occasions with two concerns for the safety of individuals, two reports of highway disruption, two calls over domestic issues, a caller reporting finding stolen number plates, and a false alarm.

Bonby

No recorded crimes in September 2015

Police received three calls relating to the same road traffic collision.

Worlaby

No recorded crimes in September 2015

Police were called on 8 occasions over matters including two minor traffic incidents and two suspicious vehicles, allegations of threats from a builder, and stones being thrown at the caller's window.

Saxby All Saints

No recorded crimes in September 2015

Police were called with a report of poachers on farmland.

Horkstow

Recorded crimes in September 2015
