Public Participation

Residents raised concerns about the extent of works to thin the wood on the bank on Horkstow Road / A1077, highlighting that they felt that too many trees were being taken out at an inappropriate time of year for wildlife.

Cllr Holloway reported that the works were being conducted under Forestry Commission Licence and formed part of a 2-3 year project to remove diseased trees together with thinning to promote regrowth and regeneration, with the project continuing up to the quarry and hillsides.

The landowner, Nelthorpe Estates, has requested that a reminder be issued to residents that the land is private, together with a warning that the thinning project may destabilise neighbouring trees which may pose a danger if there are winter gales.
