19/20 – FPC0204 Flood Defence Works

- a) Councillors discussed the following points:
 - i) There had been little progress with the works since the last meeting due to the Winter shutdown
 - ii) Monthly design works meetings had been held over the Winter period. The majority of discussions have been around alternative designs for the temporary gates across the A1077.
 The preferred design at present is sliding gates with a channel across the road, which will require piling. This may disturb the colony of Daubenton's bats under the sluice, however this is a maternity roost, so piling will be delayed until they have dispersed, which is expected to be October.
 - iii) The amendment to the design of the gates across the A1077 is classed as a substantial change to the original planning permission, so a new application covering this change will need to be submitted.
 Public engagement events will be held as part of the consultation period.
 - iv) It is likely that the Village section of the bank will be completed between March and May.
 - v) Cllr Haddon reported that the visits to Winteringham and South Ferriby Schools with the contractors and JBA Bentley went well. There are no further community activities planned at present.
 - vi) The 3 weekly rolling updates are back in place on the Parish Council website.
 - vii)Councillors discussed the information request from a local resident.
